

Tri-City Christian Academy High School Prom Dress Guidelines

Parents are expected to monitor and approve clothing according to these guidelines.

Ladies Dress

Ladies, **APPROVED** dresses are:

1. Strapless or spaghetti strap dresses are acceptable; provided the dress does not over-expose the student.
2. Note: If you choose a strapless dress, please make sure it fits snugly and will not slip down while you are dancing. Pulling your dress up and “adjusting yourself” takes away from the sophisticated look you want!
3. ONLY tea-length and long dresses are permitted.

Dresses **NOT APPROVED** are:

1. Dresses with bare mid-drifts or open back dresses.
2. Dresses with holes or mesh or other sheer materials.
3. Dresses that expose the chest, sides, or abdominal area.
4. Dresses with low-cut or plunging necklines. A dress that may be acceptable on one person may expose too much on another one. You may need to try on a number of dresses to find the one that is fashionable, complimentary and reasonable.
5. Dresses with side slits not in compliance with the length limitation.

*Young ladies who come to the Prom in a dress that does not meet the approved guidelines will be asked to alter the dress to meet the guidelines or asked to leave.

Men's Dress

1. Young men must wear dress pants, dress shirt, tie, jacket, and dress shoes.

The dress code for the Prom is formal. Any questions regarding dress should be resolved before that evening. Only students and their guests meeting the dress requirements will be admitted into the Prom.

1. No dancing or activity that imitates explicit sexual actions or behavior.
2. No kissing or hugging at the prom.
3. Arms around each other from the waist-up is fine (No touching below the waist).
4. No sitting on laps.
5. No substance or alcohol use at the prom. **Students may not bring bags, backpacks, and the like into the prom.**
6. Once inside the building, students may not leave the dance before 10:00pm. Exceptions to the departure time must be given to the Student Council Advisor (Ms. Tarleton) at least 24 hours before the prom; OR the student must be accompanied by his/her parent(s).
7. Once the student leaves the prom he/she may no reenter. **NO EXCEPTIONS**
8. Students may arrive starting at 6:00pm. *Grand March* is an opportunity for students and parents to take pictures at the venue. It takes place from 6:00-6:30pm and the dinner follows at 6:30pm.
9. No one is allowed into the prom after 6:30pm.
10. All guests must follow the guidelines.

Consequences

- Students will be given one warning for inappropriate behavior and then a student will be asked to leave.
- Students displaying continued disrespect or belligerence to those in authority will be asked to leave.
