On the first day of school, your student(s) will be given a student accident insurance brochure, which provides information about accident insurance for both a school time only plan and a twenty-four hour plan. If you do not receive a brochure, please obtain one through the school office. We strongly recommend your serious consideration of this opportunity.

If you do not have any family medical insurance, signing up for this accident insurance is mandated by your registration contract. If you do have family medical insurance, you may still want to consider purchasing the insurance offered by the school.

Over the years Tri-City Christian Academy has had very few accidents, but it is our responsibility as parents and educators to do all within our power to provide protection for the children that God has entrusted to us.
